Boot Camp w / Jason Bell from Cubed Fitness: (K-2) \$35

Have extra energy and recess isn't paying off? Come on out and join Jason Bell for some fun and fitness with your friends. Improve your coordination, teamwork, and health because play is good for everyone.

Flamenco Dance: (K-5) \$35

Junior Theatre: (3-5) \$35
