Dear McKinley Families,

We had a great turnout for Back to School Night held on Thursday, September 22nd. I hope you received information from your child's teacher that helps you support your child at home. Mark your calendar now for Parent Conferences scheduled for November 29, 30, December 1, and 2. These four days are minimum days and students are dismissed at 12:55 p.m. Every parent is expected to attend the conference where you will receive your child's report card and have the opportunity to review your child's progress toward meeting grade level standards in all areas. Teachers will send home a conference sign-up schedule in the near future. Our goal is to meet with 100% of our parents!

During the past two weeks, students have started the "Wheel" where they receive instruction in Spanish, music, and visit the library with Mrs. Cervantes. During this instructional period, teachers meet in Professional Learning Committees at each grade level to plan instruction, review student achievement, and strengthen their implementation of the IB program. This year, the district has supported our Spanish program by providing a teacher for 1.5 days per week. Please welcome Mr. Tirado to our campus. His days at McKinley are Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon. He is working with students in grades K and 1, and will oversee the computer lab for students to use Rosetta Stone on Tuesday afternoons. Students in grades 2-5 are receiving Spanish instruction from IES Language Foundation. Please visit their organization online at www.ieslanguages.org. The PTC/Foundation is currently funding the Spanish instruction with IES and music for grades K-3. We are thankful to all of you who support the

PTC/Foundation with your generous donations and participation in our fundraising events so we can continue to offer our students a rich educational program!

Attendance Counts!

As of September 30, we have been in school for 18 days. After 18 days, McKinley's portion of lost ADA (Average Daily Attendance) to our district totals \$5,588.50. Please make sure your child attends on time every day! With cold and flu season approaching, I know you will take every measure to keep your child healthy for school! Each month, I will recognize classes and students who have perfect attendance and no tardies. Attendance data will be posted in our newsletter each month.
