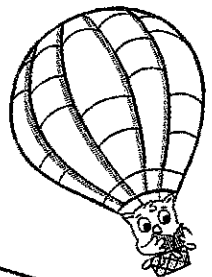
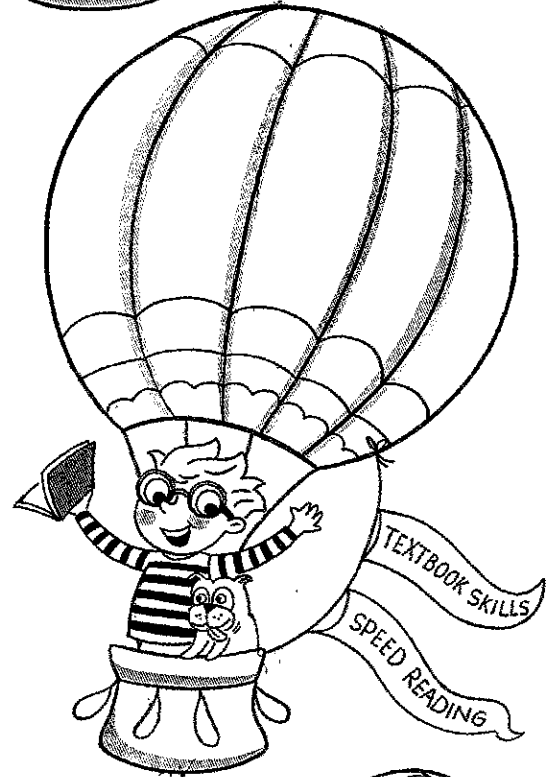

Children build solid phonics and word-attack skills and develop reading fluency and strong comprehension. Your child will be excited about books and reading and get off to a great start in second grade.

Entering 3rd Graders: In this fun summer program, your child will become a fluent, confident reader. Children develop long-word decoding skills, reading fluency, and excellent comprehension. Your child will develop a lifelong love of books and reading and get off to a great start in third grade.

Entering 4th Graders and Entering 5th Graders: In these fun and effective summer programs, your child will become a skilled, enthusiastic reader. Students develop strong comprehension skills in both fiction and non-fiction and learn how to read and study textbooks. Your child will gain confidence and develop a lifelong love of books and reading.

Entering 6th-8th Graders and Entering 9th-11th Graders: In these effective and enjoyable summer programs, our average student will improve comprehension in both fiction and non-fiction and learn to read twice as fast.
