IES Policies

1. There are **no** refunds for classes attended, enrollment fees or materials received.
2. Installment payments: IES **is not** responsible for sending installment notices. Credit cards will automatically be charged on your due date. If paying by check, postdated checks are recommended to avoid late fees.
3. Late fees will apply to all outstanding accounts at a minimum of \$20.
4. No refunds after 30 days for unattended classes. If an emergency situation occurs, and your child must drop the program after 30 days, the refund amount will be based on the refund rate of \$15.00 per class attended plus the nonrefundable enrollment fee and any room rental fees that may apply.
5. Registrations are entered on a first come, first serve basis. You will receive confirmation from IES either by email or phone before class begins. Your child **CANNOT** attend class until you have received this confirmation.
6. We expect to begin all classes on the scheduled start date, however rather than cancel a class (due to low enrollment), we reserve the right to postpone the start date or combine classes. IES reserves the right to cancel a class or drop students from a class at any time for the betterment of the program.
7. Students must be picked up within 5 minutes of class dismissal at the location of their language class. Parents must have a back up plan for picking up their students and include the name and contact number for the emergency back up. A **minimum** late pick up fee of \$10 will be charged for students not picked up within 10 minutes of dismissal, payable to the instructor on the spot.
